Summary of By-Elections

The October 13, 1988, resignation of **David D. Stupich**, the first member for the Nanaimo Electoral District, and the October 27, 1988, resignation of **Kim Campbell**, the first member for the Vancouver-Point Grey Electoral District, created vacancies in the membership of the Legislative Assembly.

Pre-by-election registrations of voters were performed within the said Electoral Districts and concluded with Writ day voters lists of:

Electoral District	Registered Voters
Nanaimo	45,961
Vancouver-Point Grey	55,605

The preceding figures compare favourably with the number of names on the voters list as of Writ day for the 1986, Provincial General Election (September 24) which shows 39,604 registered voters in Nanaimo and 46,537 registered voters in Vancouver-Point Grey.

Included with the activities of pre-by-election registration of voters in Nanaimo, were comparisons of the voters list with names in the telephone directories in order to identify prospective voters who were not registered. Telephone calls were made to people identified and they were advised of how they could become registered.

On February 15, 1989, pursuant to Orders-in-Council 194 and 195, **Writs of Election** were issued by the Chief Electoral Officer to **Shirley Lance** and **Tamarah Moss**, the respective Returning Officers for Nanaimo and Vancouver-Point Grey. The Writs ordered that elections be held in each Electoral District on March 15, 1989.

Thursday, March 2 was designated as the day for the nomination of candidates; early voting in the offices of the Returning Officers commenced on Friday, March 3; and four days of advance polling began on Wednesday, March 8. Two registration periods were available to unregistered voters to allow them to have their names added to the voters list during the 29-day interval. These periods were Wednesday, February 15 to Friday, February 24, and Monday, March 6 to Saturday, March 11, 1989. In Nanaimo, a total of 1,498 voters registered during these periods concluding with an Election Day voters list of 47,459 names. In Vancouver-Point Grey, 2,208 voters registered resulting in an Election Day voters list of 57,813 names.

During the Section 80 registration period, there were complaints from a number of residents who recently moved into the two Electoral Districts and were unable to register because they were already on a voters list in another Electoral District. These citizens were of the opinion that during by-elections, the relevant Section of the Election Act which prohibits the registration of applicants who are registered elsewhere in the Province, should not apply. Although residents who are registered elsewhere at the time a Writ of election is issued are eligible to change their registration during the ten-day period immediately following the issue of the Writ of election, **I agree, nonetheless, with the concerns of these citizens and will be recommending that registration during by-elections be permitted under the authority of Section 80.**

The official results for both elections were announced by the Returning Officers on Monday, March 20, 1989. **Ms. Jan Pullinger** and **Mr. Tom Perry**, both endorsed by the New Democratic Party, were declared duly elected as the second members to represent, respectively, the Nanaimo and Vancouver-Point Grey Electoral Districts in the Legislative Assembly.

On receipt of the Writs of Election and the Certificates of Election from the Returning Officers on Return Day, Monday, April 3, 1989, the Chief Electoral Officer confirmed to the Deputy Provincial Secretary, the election of **Ms. Pullinger** and **Mr. Perry** to the Provincial Legislature.
