Section 275 of the <i>Election Act</i> establishes that the provincial voters list may be used for municipal electoral purposes, and that a privacy policy must be approved by Elections BC for any organization accessing personal information. Section 76 of the <i>Local Government Act</i> establishes that a bylaw may be established to adopt the provincial voters list as the register of resident electors.
