Voting by mail

This package contains everything you need to vote by mail in the by-election. Step-by-step instructions are provided below. Follow the steps carefully so your package is complete and your vote counts.

Please read all the information at the top of this brochure, then follow the step-by-step instructions below to complete your voting package. Please note that you will need a witness to be present when you complete and sign the certification envelope. They will also have to sign as a witness.

Voter registration

When you requested this voting package, Elections BC checked to see if you are registered to vote and if your registration is current. If your registration is not current, this package will include an application for registration and a pamphlet on registering in conjunction with alternative absentee voting.

If these forms are not included, your voter registration status has been confirmed. If you are concerned that your registration is not current, contact Elections BC (see contact information on back panel).

Candidates

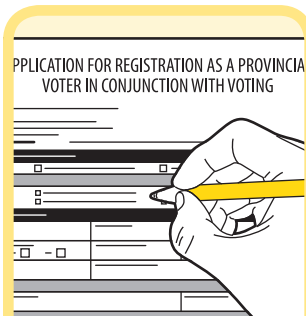
The names of the candidates in your electoral district will be available from the **District Electoral Officer** after the candidate nomination period closes. If you requested this package after that, it will include a list of candidates.

Your home address

Your certification envelope should be pre-filled with your home address information. If your home address has not been entered, or has been entered incorrectly, please contact the **District Electoral Officer** who issued your package to confirm that your voter registration is current.

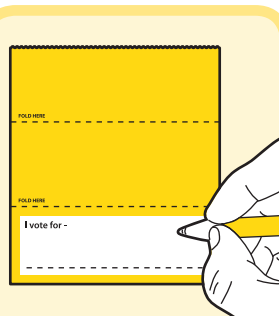
Returning your package

Your completed voting package must be received by the **District Electoral Officer** who issued it to you **no later than 8 p.m. (Pacific time) on General Voting Day**. If mailing from outside of Canada, postage is required.



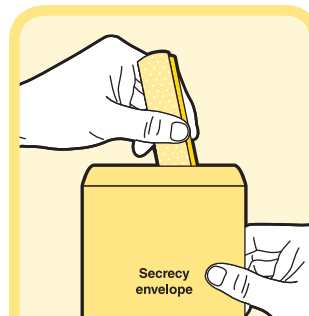
1. Register to vote

If an application form is included with this package, complete it in full. For more information, see the Voter Registration section above.



2. Mark the ballot

Print the name of the candidate or registered political party of your choice in the white box on the ballot. The names of the candidates in your electoral district will be available from your **District Electoral Officer** after the candidate nomination period closes.



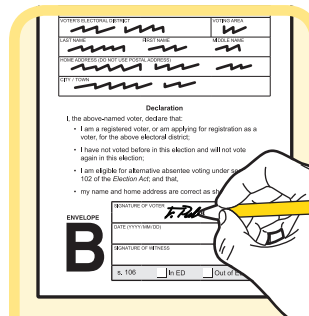
3. Put your marked ballot into the secrecy envelope (A)

Fold the ballot. Place it in the *secrecy envelope* (A) and seal the envelope.



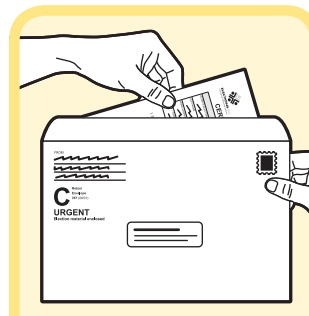
4. Put the secrecy envelope (A) into the certification envelope (B)

Seal the *certification envelope* (B).



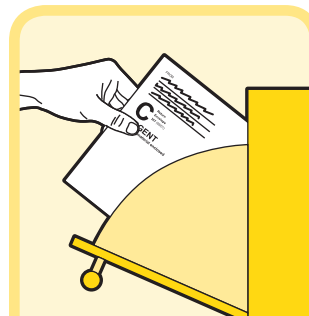
5. Sign the certification envelope

Read the declaration on the front of the *certification envelope* (B) before signing. Ask someone to watch you sign. This person must sign as the witness. **If this envelope is not signed by you and a witness, your vote will not be counted.**



6. Put the certification envelope (B) into the pre-addressed return envelope (C)

Read the checklist on the back of the *return envelope* (C) and ensure any required forms have been completed. Put completed forms into the *return envelope* (C) and seal it.



7. Mail the return envelope (C)

Ballots must be received by your District Electoral Officer no later than 8 p.m. (Pacific time) on General Voting Day. Late arrivals will not be counted.
