MLA Dan Davies often failed to notify Constituents of important and relevant information in a timely manner through Media, Emails or Community Meetings. When invited to such meetings to answer questions or give clarity was visibly absent or provided any follow up. Matters include pending Legislation, upcoming Bills put in front of BC Legislature including but not limited to; The Infants Act, Bill 36, UNDRIP, School Curriculum, reduction of Health Care workers and services.

When approached individually by constituents or small groups again no follow up or a form letter was used. His choosing to ignore their concerns in such matters often allowed the passing of, or changes to Legislation detrimental to the Constituents in his riding therefore allowing them to have no input.
